Library Club- The students have spoken and they love to read! Khalifae will take a group to read and discuss fun literature picked by the children.

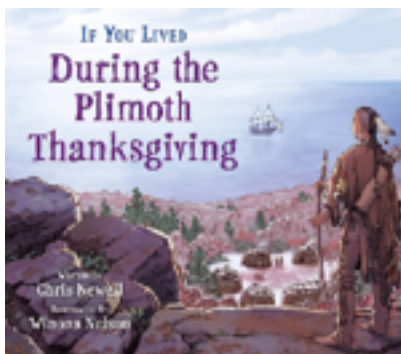
BOOKS OF THE MONTH
