In this club, the children will have the opportunity to learn a choreographed routine that they will perform at our Dance Competition in April!

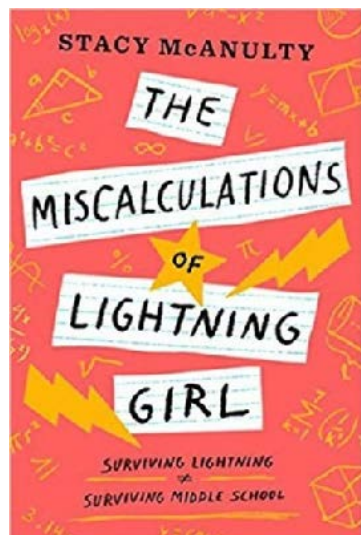
BOOKS OF THE MONTH
