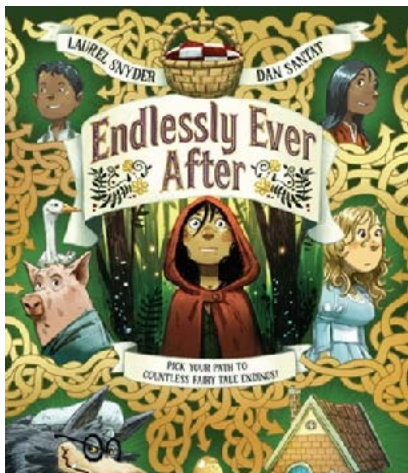
The Play

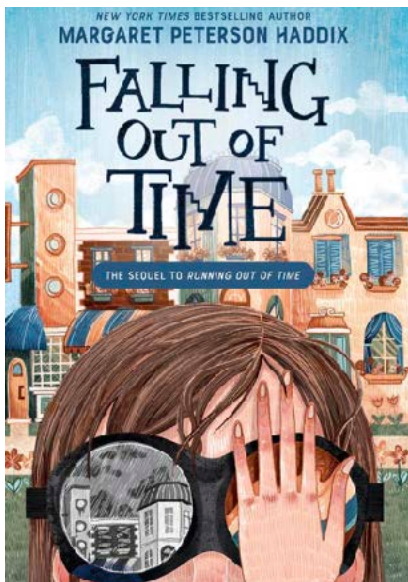
BOOKS OF THE MONTH
