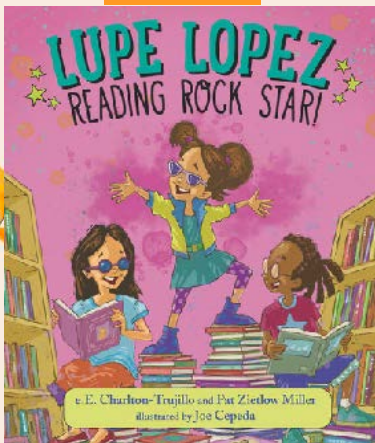
Learn new moves and show off your dancing skills as we prepare for KidsCo's Dance Competition on April 10th.

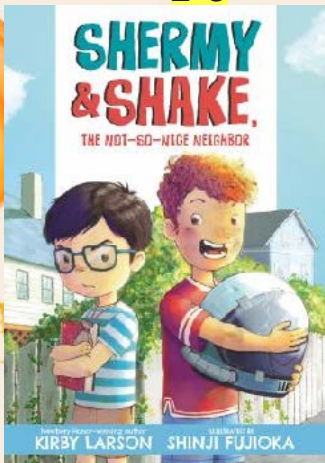
