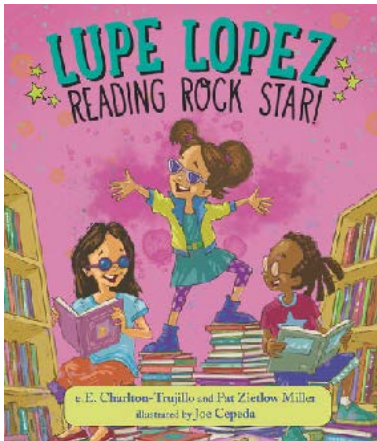

K-1



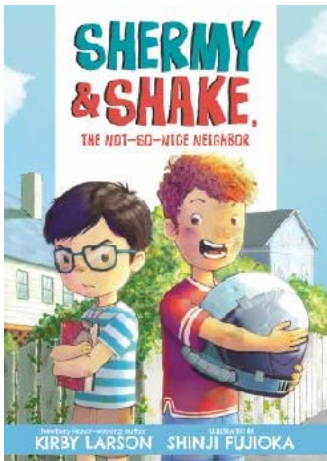
