**Science Club with Abraham! The kids will be exploring all areas science has to offer from erupting volcanos to laws of gravity! We are so excited to see what he has planned.**

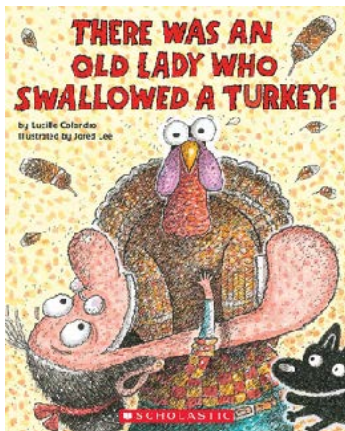

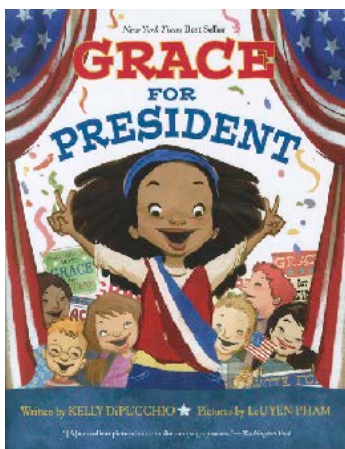
## BOOKS OF THE MONTH

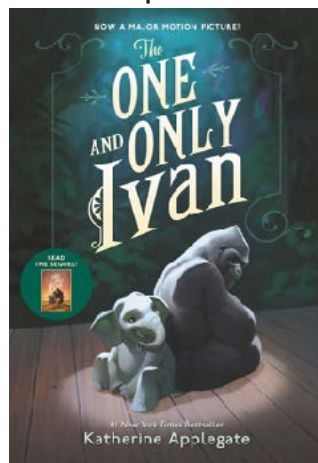
